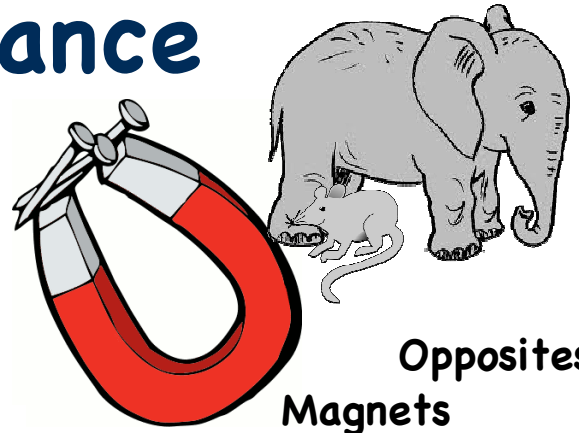

Creative Dance – All classes have the opportunity for the participants to choreograph themselves. **Creative Dance can also be used to explore any theme.**

Sound – Key stage 2; Using STOMP and other dance games the class explores what sounds tell us about the world around us, how sound travels and high and low pitch. At the end they will have their own ‘class rhythm’ that can be performed at any time and a group performance piece.
